- (1) latent defects in hull or machinery, breakage of shafts or bursting of boilers (excluding the cost and expense of replace or repairing the defective part, broken shaft or burst boiler)
- (2) the negligence of any person whatsoever, but excluding the cost of making good any defect resulting from either negligence or breach of contract in respect of any repair or alternation work carried out for the account of the Assured and/or the Owners or in respect of the maintenance of the Vessel
- (3) heavy weather.
