Application Checklist

- ❖ **Application Form**
 - Only write in capital letters.
 - Sign and date application.
 - Complete Israeli ID (*teudat zehut*) number (9 digits), if any.
- ❖ **Curriculum Vitae or Resume**
- ❖ **Israeli Identity Card** (*teudat zehut / oleh / toshav ara 'i*), if applicable, must be photocopied and submitted with the application.
- ❖ **Application Fee**
 - This payment covers costs for the application packet and the processing of the application and is nonrefundable.
 - Applicants abroad pay US\$115 or €85. The application fee must be in the form of a check payable to Ben Gurion University, and attached to the application.
- ❖ **Academic Records** (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) must be official or notarized. If the original documents are in a language **other** than Hebrew or English, a notarized Hebrew or English translation is required.
- ❖ **Israeli Bagrut Certificate** must be submitted in order to receive a Hebrew language exemption. The candidate's knowledge of Hebrew must be sufficient to participate in normal conversation. Candidates will be given a Hebrew proficiency exam. If the candidate does not meet the Hebrew language proficiency requirement, every effort will be made in assistance.
- ❖ **Course descriptions of previous studies** are vital for applicants requesting advanced status in B.A./ B.Sc. programs. Applicants to M.A. programs who will want to request exemption from supplementary courses should also prepare course descriptions.
